Kurze Erklärung (auf Deutsch)

Das **Past Participle (3. Verbform)** wird im Englischen in verschiedenen Strukturen verwendet:

1 Present Perfect

have / has + past participle

→ beschreibt Handlungen mit Bezug zur Gegenwart

Example:

She **has finished** her homework.

2 Passive Voice

be + past participle

→ wenn wichtig ist, **was passiert**, nicht **wer es tut**

Example:

The bridge **was built** in 2005.

3 Als Adjektiv oder verkürzter Nebensatz (participle clause)

Example:

The book **written** by the author became famous.

(= The book **that was written** by the author...)
