Das **Past Participle** ist die **3. Verbform** im Englischen.

Beispiele:

- go → **gone**
- eat → **eaten**
- play → **played**

Man benutzt das Past Participle vor allem:

1 Im Present Perfect

have/has + past participle

Example:

She **has finished** her homework.

2 Im Passive

be + past participle

Example:

The book **was written** in 1990.

3 Als Adjektiv

Example:

a **broken** window
